



## Summer Sunday Symphonies with the Yakima Symphony Orchestra

### Recommendations from Cave B Summer Music Theater Venue:

- **WEAR & BRING:** We recommend that you wear sturdy shoes and bring a hat, sunglasses and sunscreen for our desert daytime temperatures. A sweater or light jacket is appropriate for most evenings. A small flashlight is recommended for uneven footing as you make your way back to your car after the event.
- **SEATING - BRING A CHAIR or a BLANKET:** Seating is all general admission, festival seating on the lawn in front of our tasting room. You may bring a small blanket, cushion or lawn chair. We encourage you to bring low lawn chairs. You may bring taller ones if necessary, but please be aware that lawn chairs that are taller than 3 inches off the ground may be asked to be moved farther back, so others may see. There is handicapped seating on the balcony that will accommodate a wheelchair.
- **WINE:** Cave B Wine will be available by the glass or bottle for Summer Music Theater Events during the show starting at 6:00pm. Bringing in outside alcohol is prohibited due to local and state liquor laws and will be strictly enforced.
- **FOOD:** You are welcome to bring in your own snacks, picnic dinner and non-alcoholic beverages. We will have cheese, charcuterie and fruit and bread plates available as well as a few sweet items. Next door to the Cave B Summer Music Theater is Tendrils Restaurant (a 5-7-minute walk) from the venue for pre-show dining. Reservations are encouraged.
