Auditions to be held at The Capitol Theatre, Yakima, WA

***To begin in the 2019-2020 performance season (September 2019)**

- **Regular Season** runs September through May, currently 12 concert sets totaling 46 services
- **Additional** orchestra and/or chamber ensemble sets may be offered throughout the year
- **Compensation is currently** \$113 per service + per diem (*dependent upon residence and services*)
- **Rehearsal Schedule:** 2-3 DAY CONDENSED SETS
- **Housing may be provided upon request**

Audition requirements:

- *Highly qualified candidates should submit a one-page résumé, no later than **January 25, 2019**.
- *A \$100.00 deposit is required to hold your slot. Deposit will be returned at audition or if cancellation is made at least 2 days prior to the audition day. Remit all items to: Yakima Symphony Orchestra, atten: Mary, 32 North Third Street, Suite 333, Yakima, WA 98901.
- **The successful candidate must hold valid U.S. work authorization document.*
- **If the seat is won by a current member of the YSO, his/her seat may be offered to a runner up.*

Preliminary auditions are screened, with the repertoire drawn from the following literature:

- I. Solo:** First movement exposition from a standard concerto of the candidate's choice
- II. Orchestral excerpts:**

Stravinsky: *Petrushka* – Ballerina Solo

Mussorgsky/Ravel: *Pictures at an Exhibition* – First Promenade and
“Samuel Goldenberg and Schmuyle” (No. 58 to No. 62)

Beethoven: **Leonore Overture No. 3** – Fanfares

Mahler: **Symphony No. 5** – Opening Solo

Rimsky-Korsakov: *Scheherazade* – movement IV, C to E and P to R

John Williams: *Star Wars Suite* – Main Title
